


Neighborhood Place Planning Map:

 Selected Area for Lafayette Parish for January, 2008*



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
Neighborhood Place Planning Map:

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



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

A note on Zip Codes: Zip Code Areas, when mapped, are not created or maintained by the U.S. Postal Service, but have been developed by mapping software or other data compilation companies to assist in the geographic display of data. Zip Code Areas (or "Zip-5") are based on street addresses and will therefore show some differences when compared with other datasets, such as Zip Code Tabulation Areas (ZCTAs) which are used by the US Census Bureau. A Zip Code that is contained in multiple parishes is assigned to the parish where the majority of the population is located, and will be only used in parish-wide calculations for the parish to which it has been assigned.

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


Neighborhood Place Planning Map: Population Shift from 2000 to 2007 by Census Tract for Lafayette Parish*

Population change by Census Tract from 2000 to 2007 has been overlaid by Zip Code Tabulation Area (ZCTA), and does not represent a statistical analysis of the data.

About ZCTAs and Zip Codes: U.S. Census Bureau ZCTAs are similar, but not directly comparable to, Zip Code Areas. ZCTAs group block level census data within the same zip code. Alternately, Zip Code Areas, when mapped, are not created or maintained by the U.S. Postal Service, but have been developed by mapping software or other data compilation companies to assist in the geographic display of data. Zip Code Areas are based on street addresses and will therefore show some differences when compared with the Census ZCTAs. ZCTAs ending in "HH" generally indicate water areas. ZCTAs ending in "XX" are applied to a large land area (usually larger than 25 square miles) where the US Census had insufficient information to determine the five-digit codes. A ZCTA that is contained in multiple parishes is assigned to the parish where the majority of the population is located and will be only used in parish-wide calculations for the parish to which it has been assigned.
